Wednesday May 6 2009, SALVATION

This past weekend, over 225 people received Christ at WOW Jam and 71 were baptized in water. In addition to that, approximately 35 to 40 people received Christ at Koinonia and 37 people were baptized during the two morning services.

Wednesday May 13, 2009 BROKENESS

Wednesday, May 20 SECURITY

Wednesday May 27, 2009 AUTHORITY

Seek God on behalf of Law Enforcement Officials that they would function in a principled patience and gentle authority. Ask God for their protection of body and emotions and strength and blessings for their families.

Seek God on behalf of those who are spiritually dead and rebellious. May they come into contact with a living gospel! Seek Him to transform their lives by a power encounter with the ultimate authority. Bring them to a point of submission to the governing authorities that have been established for their benefit.

Rom. 13:1 ¶ Everyone must submit himself to the governing authorities, for there is no authority except that which God has established. The authorities that exist have been established by God. 2 Consequently, he who rebels against the authority is rebelling against what God has instituted, and those who do so will bring judgment on themselves. 3 For rulers hold no terror for those who do right, but for those who do wrong. Do you want to be free from fear of the one in authority? Then do what is right and he will commend you. NIV
