





# THE FOUR DIMENSION OF A LEADER'S FAITH SESSION I DR BODDY HILL



### Faith sees the invisible, believes the incredible, and receives the impossible.

Good leadership is about leveraging the influence I have in a beneficial way to others-to live a faith-filled life will result in an increase in my influence.

Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see. Hebrews 11:1

"A little faith takes your soul to heaven–great faith brings heaven to your soul." Charles Spurgeon

Dimension #1: See it – Faith's \_\_\_\_\_

- It is not our big problems that defeat us, but our small faith.
- Our faith walk is based on seeing with the eyes of faith.
- If you can't see it, you can't believe it.
- Bible Example: \_\_\_\_\_ Genesis 13:14-15–God wanted Abraham to look and see His inheritance.
- Four Areas to Focus your sight on:
  - a) My \_\_\_\_\_\_ –Who am I in Christ?
  - b) My \_\_\_\_\_\_ –What is His unchangeable character?
  - c) My \_\_\_\_\_\_ –What has God promised you?
  - d) My \_\_\_\_\_\_ –What provisions has the Lord blessed you with?

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### Dimension #2: Believe it-Faith's \_\_\_\_\_

- Romans 10:10–For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved.
- Mark 11:23-24–Truly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be taken up and thrown into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that what he says will come to pass, it will be done for him.
- Faith begins in your \_\_\_\_\_\_. It is involves believing in your heart regardless of the natural circumstances around you.
- Heart = Your renewed human spirit
- To believe with all of our heart is to believe with our spirit, to believe independently of our mind or our body. Kenneth Hagin
- You can have a powerhouse of faith in your heart to change the world through your leadership, but it must be released.

### Dimension #3: Say it-Faith's \_\_\_\_\_

- Our faith is not real until we have declared it openly and boldly.
- Romans 10:8

- 2 Corinthians 4:13–It is written: "I believed; therefore I have spoken." Since we have that same spirit of faith, we also believe and therefore speak.
- Bible Example: Caleb, Numbers 14:30; Joshua 14:13

# LEADER SHIP SELF ASSESSMENT



### Leadership Self Assessment

This self assessment is designed to help Christian leaders determine which leadership skills they may need to develop. It focuses on eight components dealing with (1) providing direction, (2) leading courageously, (3) fostering teamwork, (4) championing change, (5) coaching people, (6) motivating others, (7) building relationships and (8) acting with integrity. A set of 5 statements reflect various attributes of and skills for each component.

### Instructions:

Please read each statement carefully. Then rate yourself in terms of how well you think you possess the attribute or perform the leadership skill by circling the statement that best reflects your view. This is not a test – there are no right or wrong answers.

### The rating scale provides three choices:

1 = I do not possess this attribute or do this skill well at all.

2 = I seldom possess this attribute or do this skill somewhat well.

3 = I possess this attribute or do this skill very well.

Please respond to every statement. In selecting your response, be realistic about your assessment. Do not answer in terms of how you would like to see yourself, in terms of what you should be doing, or in terms of how you think others view you. Again, the purpose of this assessment is to help you focus on growth objectives that will stretch you in meaningful ways.




