4. Valley Gate – The principle of humility (1 Pet. 5:5).
5. Dung Gate – The principle of elimination (2 Cor. 7:1).
6. Fountain Gate – The principle of the Spirit-filled life (Jn. 7:38; Eph. 5:18).
7. Water Gate – The principle of His word working in our lives (Matt. 4:4; Eph. 5:26).
8. Horse Gate – The principle of warfare (Eph. 6:11).
9. East Gate – The principle of expectation and relationship with Christ.
10. Inspection Gate – The principle of the conviction of the Holy Spirit (Heb. 3:7-8).
