C. TEN ATTITUDES OF A BONDSERVANT

1. Created for service [Eph. 2:10]

Christians with purpose are world changers.

2. Saved for service [II Tim. 1:9]

Service and ministry are interchangeable words.

3. Called to service [Gal. 1:15]

We usually think of callings being reserved for missionaries and forget that they're for us as well.

4. Gifted for service [I Pet. 4:10]

Our unique abilities are expressions of God's nature.

5. My church family needs my service [I Cor. 12:25-27]

When a Christian stops functioning, it makes the rest of us sick.

6. When I serve others, I serve God [Col. 3:23-24; Matt. 25:34-46]

Every hungry child is named Jesus.

7. God's mercy provokes my service [Rom. 12:1]

I don't serve Him out of duty or fear, but because of gratitude.

8. Service makes my life meaningful [Mark 8:35; I Cor. 15:58]

It's not how long you live that matters, it's how you live.

9. I will be accountable for my servanthood [Rom. 14:12]

In the last day God will ask you,

"What did you do with what I gave you?"

10. Servanthood will be rewarded throughout eternity [John 12:26; Matt. 25:23]
